Reading

<u>Please use the time children are reading with you to ask them questions about the text-this helps their understanding and is so important.</u> Children are expected to read every day for 10 minutes and have this recorded in their reading record. Please make sure it is your child's library book or reading book that is recorded in their reading record. Reading books and library books are changed every Friday.

Children continue to read both independently and in whole class or small groups. We use Reading VIPERS in our guided reading lessons to help us answer a variety of comprehension questions.

Times tables

This term we are starting a new Times Tables scheme. The children should be familiar with 1, 2, 3, 5, and 10 times tables and we are continuing to work on the 4 and 8 times tables. Please support your child by practicing their Time Tables with them.

<u>Spellings</u>

Spellings will be given out each **Friday**. Children can use spelling shed to practice spellings at home. They will have a weekly spelling test the following **Friday**.
