Money Owed

E.W has emailed a final request for monies owed. It has been offered in two instalments: One at the end of January and one at the end of February. If this has not happened E.W will take it further. D.W and C.J are confirming how much that is owed.

Reflect on XMAS disco and last term:

Profit appears to be low; it was £500 + £170 (RAFFLE) but we have a lot of Elfridges supplies left and Santa prizes for next year.

Online raffle from last year raised over £200 which is more profitable and easier to manage.

A lot of tuck shop left too so less needed for Easter Disco.

Sauce and serviettes will be needed.

Current amount is: £850 to come in

Last year had 2 big out goings: Tea Towels & Bike shelter. But monies owed should be more than the tea towels cost as they were run with a profit margin.

<u>Charitie legalities –</u>

CJ has gone through the constitution from Parent Kind and has shared key components we need to ensure we adhere to.

<u>Wonderdome – Space inflatable or school that teaches each class– CJ will chase up prices.</u> As part of FOA constitution we have committed to large projects to improve children's educational experience. This can be a donation from PTA or chargeable.

We need some more prizes for this but to keep in mind we must ask for the summer fayre too.

<u>Carnival – 14th June</u> Suggested we ask parents to sort their children and FOA give a fixed amount for main structures and props.

Carnival was expensive and taxing on PTA last year. Support was asked from parents and nonattended the sessions. C suggested to get a table at carnival to raise funds. CJ to investigate it, we haven't done this before because committee tend to be in the carnival and no one free to run it. We could book a non-uniform day for Tombola prizes.

C suggested selling uniform more regularly on rails at school. E.W will look at the logistics of it, possibly google form once a month with the need to let parents mention what is needed.

Due to not having many members of PTA, we have previously had to cut back to Discos and summer fayres. As more people are joining new ideas are being shared and previous things we have done can be brought back in. As part of the constitution if a member comes up with an idea and wants to run with it, a committee member should be volunteering their time to support the running of the activity.

- Baking class with the children Pizza dough and homemade pizza to take home
- CJ suggested next Christmas gingerbread house/ people (depending on age) decorating
- Community larder involvement for Movie nights
- Victorian Fayre (concern over booking it in advance because last time over 10 people cancelled last minute leaving a handful to hold the fort and one for the last 3 hours, not a lot donated so one member made a lot of things and we were not allowed a tombola)

A lot of ideas given but to make these happen we need more people to lead events.

CJ – Year 6 hoodies, PTA have always bought a gift for year 6. In past years the cups have broken, and children have requested hoodies. These are expensive so PTA donate the funds they normally would for a gift and the year 6 raise the rest. Year 6 would like to run an Easter raffle with eggs they buy themselves and create a hamper. As PTA does not usually do an Easter raffle year 6 are asking permission.

Permission voted and agreed on

OCADO and York chocolate story have been contacted in regard to donations and will respond hopefully in time for Wonka shop. We shall ask book shops and buy small gifts like bubbles and small sweets.

CJ brought up the possibility of committee members who would like to have a first aid course and a DBS check. This should help staff at events as we can then be left to do activities with the children. – voted and agreed.

PTA can access different grants that school can. CJ will investigate this and see if there is anything relevant for us currently

C mentioned the hampers could be made smaller and more of them. It has been suggested last year but due to lack of volunteers at the run up to Christmas we didn't have time. Going forward members have volunteered to bag them with any donated gift bags. C also suggested it can be sealed gift bags so more a surprise.

10th July is the Summer Fayre. CJ has requested we kindly ask school staff if we can do it on a Saturday. Many parents cannot attend a mid-week session. We cannot get the fire truck to come on a weekday. We could then open it for the community and have staff families more than welcome to join in too.
