- Reading at home with your child at least 3 times a week and practising their times tables.

In **English** we are: exploring the poem 'The Highwayman' and will be using drama to enhance our learning and understanding of the poem. We will also be exploring narrative adventure writing inspired by the video 'One Small Step' by Taiko Studios.

Topics will involve:

- Descriptive language
- Drama
- Discussion of emotion linked to points within the poem
- Reciting our poems including actions
- Understanding the different stanzas and points of the poem
- Learning grammar and spelling rules
- Using ambitious and sophisticated vocabulary
- Ensuring perfect punctuation

Spelling Your child will be practising phonic patterns, spelling rules and their own personal spelling mistakes. We encourage children to take ownership of their own spelling, correcting any mistakes accordingly.

Reading We teach a specific reading lesson every day. Your child will develop their reading skills through inference, deduction, retrieval and prediction lessons. To support your child it is essential you read at home with them at least 3 times a week and have discussions about the text. Please complete the reading record and sign so your child is awarded their reading dojos. We will be focussing on the text 'Cosmic' in our reading lessons.
